Obtaining an I-20 or DS-2019

The following documents must be submitted to your academic department before an I-20 or DS-2019 can be issued:

- Completed/signed CIAQ form (included in this document)
- Financial documents that are no more than six months old (see below for details)
- Copy of the passport biographical pages for yourself/your dependents (if applicable)

If you are currently in the US on an F-1 or J-1 visa at another institution, you must also submit:

- International Student SEVIS Record Release Form (located in Forms section at www.ic.uci.edu)
- Copy of visa for you and your dependents (if applicable).
- Copy of your I-94 card and the I-94 cards of any of your dependents that are staying in the US
- Copy of your current I-20 or DS-2019.

Financial Responsibility

Please note that the following figures are based on the estimates from the UCI Budget Office. The minimum costs for a UCI Graduate Student for living and educational expenses at UCI for three quarters (nine months) are:

\$27,047 for tuition and educational fees for three quarters

\$14,000 (approx.) for living expenses (housing, food, transportation, books, supplies, etc.)

MBA students must guarantee **\$54,748**. The breakdown is as follows:

\$40,748 for tuition, educational fees, and professional fees for three quarters

\$14,000 (approx.) for living expenses (housing, food, transportation, books, supplies, etc.)

UCI Law Students must guarantee **\$63,422**. The breakdown is as follows:

\$46,422 for tuition, educational fees, and professional fees for two semesters

\$17,000 (approx.) for living expenses (housing, food, transportation, books, supplies, etc.)

An additional **\$4,000** must be guaranteed if your spouse and **each** child that will be staying with you in the US with you on an F-2 or J-2 visa.

(If you will be staying in the US during the summer months, we suggest having an additional **\$4,000** for living expenses for that time.)

In addition to your tuition and fee payment, upon your arrival at UCI, you will need at least **\$4,000** for initial rent deposits, living expenses, books, and supplies for the first quarter. Since the financial burden is not evenly distributed throughout the academic year, you must plan to have sufficient funds available to meet required expenses. In particular, tuition and fees must be paid in full at the beginning of each quarter. You may, however, participate in the PACE installment plan which allow you to spread the quarterly fee payment over a three month period.

You should not expect financial assistance from UCI unless you have been officially notified in writing of such an award by your academic department or by the Dean of Graduate Studies. Even if you are considered for a teaching or research assistantship, this may not provide full financial support. Students who are not offered full financial support must submit financial verification for the difference between the amount of support that is offered by UCI and the financial verification requirement listed above. Assistantships do not include a waiver for non-resident tuition or fees unless it explicitly states such. Additionally, these sources of support may not be guaranteed beyond the first year of study.
